In the early twentieth century, a young Chinese boy joins his father in San Francisco and helps him realize his dream of making a flying machine.

These leveled discussion questions about Dragonwings require students to read closely, make connections, and share their analyses. Included are leveled comprehension questions and suggested answers.

These assessment questions for Dragonwings are modeled after current testing models requiring students to revisit the text for answers. Students have to support their opinions and inferences with examples from the text.
